3. 203 Harrison Avenue – Mr. Greene Sr. & Mr. Greene Jr. were both present. They were asked if this was just a home office and what the business was. The Greenses responded that they are

Camden Dry Wall and the home office is used for only phone, fax & mail. Planning & Zoning recommended approval of this conditional use. *Ms. Wagner made a motion to approve this conditional use for a home office. Ms. Williams seconded the motion. All in favor; none opposed.*
