## SNOW & SIDEWALKS

As most of you know the Town of Wyoming has an ordinance about clearing sidewalks after a snowfall. For those of you that do not know this, Ordinance #P2-07 states that public sidewalks, pavements or walkways must be cleared within 48 hours after the snow has stopped falling. Failure to comply may cause the Town to hire someone to clear the walks that have not been cleared and the property owner will be billed for this along with a \$50.00 fine for each incident or offense. If you are a landlord, be sure your tenants understand their responsibility in this unless you have an agreement with them to handle it yourself.

Hopefully, we will have no more snow accumulation this winter; however, we never know what is to come and want to be sure all residents understand what their responsibilities are in this matter.

If you are elderly or infirm and have no one to help you with this, please call Town Hall at 697-2966 to let us know. We will try to find someone to help you.

If you are willing to help out someone who is elderly or infirm, please let Town Hall know at 697-2966 so that we can put you on our list of helpers. Thank you.

## ELECTIONS

The Wyoming Town Council has three seats that are coming up for election in February; one is the mayor's seat and two are council seats. The mayor's term will be for three (3) years and the two council seats will be for two (2) years each. Candidates for Mayor and members of Town Council must be at least 21 years of age by the date of the election, a citizen of the State of Delaware, a qualified elector, and a bona fide domiciliary of the Town for at least one year prior to the date of the election.

The election will be held on the last Saturday of February (the 26th) from 1:00 to 8:00 p.m. at the Wyoming Annex. Those residents interested in running must file a written and signed notice of intention to seek office along with the results of a criminal background check at Wyoming Town Hall no later than 4:30 p.m. on the last Friday of January (the 28th). The background check must be obtained through the State Bureau of Investigation. They can be reached at 302-739-2528 for times and location.
