- The meeting was turned over to Mr. Kelly Crumpley, acting chairman of the Planning & Zoning Committee. Mr. Crumpley first stated that he wanted to thank Mr. B. J. DeCoursey and Ms. Linda Raab from the University Of Delaware Institute Of Public Administration for all the many hours of help they gave the Town in preparing this Comp Plan Update. As an employee of the Kent County Planning Department he has seen many different comp plans from other towns and he feels this is one of the nicest ones he has seen. He went over some of what he considers are the highlights of this update including a possible new zoning area called “waterfront” around the Wyoming Mill area in conjunction with the 3B’s property to possibly become a “gateway” to the Town. This is just a recommendation. Planning & Zoning would like to keep the Town Center as it is. This is working well for our town. The Wyoming Concrete property is remaining industrial – low intensity with maybe some commercial.
