

P D FISHING DERBY




The 2nd annual Wyoming PD Fishing Derby is scheduled for Saturday, July 30th from 9 am to 1 pm



During our investigation it was determined that there was not an abduction attempt at the ballpark.</p> <p>Due to the Wyoming Police Department receiving complaints about parking, below is a list of parking violations that pertain to the roads in the town of Wyoming:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. No parking at any place where there is a sign prohibiting such action.2. No parking wherever the curb is painted yellow.3. No parking in an intersection or crosswalk or within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection.4. No parking on a sidewalk.5. No parking in front of an alley, driveway, public or private driveway.6. No parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.7. No parking within 30 feet of a stop sign.8. No parking within 50 feet of a railroad crossing unless otherwise posted.9. YARD WASTE

After many months of working with our waste disposal company and with the Town of Camden, Wyoming has finally worked out a contract with Allied Waste for our yard waste. We will be beginning yard waste pick-ups with Allied Waste on Tuesday, July 19, 2011. The yard waste will be picked up every other week on Tuesdays, year round. Your recycling will continue to be picked up weekly on Tuesdays, and trash will be picked up every Friday as it is now.

For those of you who have received the tan yard waste bins from Delaware Solid Waste Authority, you will continue to use those bins but will not need the three tickets once July 19th gets here. For those of you who do not have a DSWA bin, you may purchase a bin of your own at a home improvement store or from Allied for a fee of \$60.00. Allied has not received their bins yet; they are on order. In the meantime, you **MUST** use biodegradable bags that are available at Lowes or Home Depot. And you may continue to use just the biodegradable bags if you wish. All yard waste that is put into a bin must be put in loosely, no bags should be used. Below is a listing of all trash dates, recycle dates and yard waste dates for pick-up through the end of 2011.
