The 2nd annual Wyoming PD Fishing Derby is scheduled for Saturday, July 30th from 9 am to 1 pm



YARD WASTE PICKUP

This is just a reminder that our first yard waste pickup through Allied Waste was on Tuesday, July 19th. If you do not have a bin, you **MUST** use **biodegradable** bags which can be purchased at Lowes or Home Depot. If you wish to purchase a bin through Allied Waste for \$60.00, please contact Wyoming Town Hall and we will order one for you. If you already have a tan bin that you got from DSWA, you may continue to use that one. You also have the option of purchasing your own bin at any home improvement store. Just be sure it is plastic; you cannot use metal cans. There is no limit to the amount of yard waste you can put out. Branches may be cut in 4 ft. lengths and bundled. You may have extra bags as long as they are **biodegradable**. Pickups will be every other Tuesday.

The Wyoming Peach Festival will be held Saturday, August 6, 2011 from 9 am until 3 pm.


