DELMARVA POWER

Last month, Delmarva Power embarked on a major project to upgrade the electric utilities within the Town of Wyoming. This project entails replacing many poles that date back to the late 1940's and early 1950's. There will be 4 phases to the entire project which will span over the next year with a completion date of Fall 2012.

You may have already seen our tree trimmers in the area, clearing lines for the work to be done. We apologize in advance for any traffic pattern changes and concerns, but we do need to look out for the safety of our workers while they work.

You may see sidewalk disruption as many of the poles are embedded in the concrete. Repairs to the sidewalks in these areas will be made in a timely manner.

As the project moves forward, we will do our best to keep everyone informed. There will be a map available in the Town Hall detailing the areas for each phase and the approximate time frame we will be in those areas.

Phase 1, which began in October, has 30 poles that have been selected to be replaced. Sidewalks will be impacted and we will need to coordinate work with Verizon as their facilities are on our poles and will need to be moved after new poles are set.

This is to inform you of an upcoming National Emergency Alert System (EAS) test as fully described on the following website address. **On November 9, 2011 at 2:00 PM ET**, the FCC, along with FEMA, will be conducting their first National Emergency Alert System (EAS) test. The national level EAS leverages the communications support of all participating cable providers. The test will be brief in duration and once the test is over, your normal programming will resume. Please note that all Video On Demand (VOD) sessions will stop as a result of the test and you may resume play upon completion of the test. **THIS IS JUST A TEST!!!**
