ELECTIONS

Yes, it is that time of year again. Elections are once again coming up in February. We will have two seats up for election, Ms. Georgette William's seat and Mr. Terry Witt's seat. If you are interested in running for one of these seats, please contact Town Hall to pick up an election packet. Candidates for Town Council must be at least 21 years of age by the date of the election, a citizen of the State of Delaware, a qualified elector, and a bona fide domiciliary of the Town for at least one year prior to the date of the election. Council members are elected for two year terms each.

The election will be held on the last Saturday of February (25th), 2012 from 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Wyoming Annex. Those residents interested in running must file a written and signed notice of intention to seek office along with the results of a criminal background check at Wyoming Town Hall no later than 4:30 p.m. on the last Friday of January (27th), 2012. The background check must be obtained through the State Bureau of Investigation. They can be reached at 302-739-2528 for times and location.

Please consider getting involved in your Town. If you don't wish to run for Council, please come out and vote. Anyone out of town or homebound may vote by absentee ballot which will be available by contacting Town Hall, 302-697-2966.

As soon as this work is complete, we will begin removing the old poles and wire and sidewalk repairs. We anticipate Phase II work to begin on schedule in January.
