REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Rife called the Meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

- *Ms. Williams made a motion to adopt the agenda as published. Mr. Witt seconded the motion. All in favor; none opposed.*

ADOPTION OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

- *Ms. Stokes made a motion to approve all three of the previous month's minutes. Mr. Witt seconded the motion. All in favor; none opposed.*

TREASURER'S REPORT

- *Ms. Williams presented the Treasurer's Report. Mr. Witt made a motion seconded by Ms. Stokes to accept the Treasurer's Report subject to audit. All in favor; none opposed.*

POLICE REPORT – Chief Martin Willey

- *Chief Willey gave the police report for April. The written report is part of the packet. He stated that his officers will start issuing tickets for parking violations on North CR Avenue now. Everyone seems to be happy with what we have done with the parking on CR Avenue. There have been no negative comments.*

FIRE COMPANY REPORT

- Mr. Fred Jester was not able to be present at this meeting but had dropped off the April report at Town Hall. During the month of April the fire company had 199 ambulance calls and 38 fire calls.
- This month the average on-the-road time for the apparatus was 22.9 hours, average number of volunteers responding per alarm was 14 and there was an average of 8 calls per day.
- Margie, the VP of the Auxiliary, announced the Penny Auction that the auxiliary will be putting on June 9, 2012 from 4:00 to 8:00 p.m. Should be a lot of fun.

- No one was present to give a report.

#### BUILDING INSPECTOR REPORT/ CODE VIOLATION REPORT

- Mr. Snyder was not available to give a report; however, written Bldg. Insp. Report is in the packets. Ms. Haddick stated that she is in the process of getting out new violation letters – the report will be updated for next month.

#### C/W SEWER & WATER REPORT

- Mr. Jim Winchell reported on the joint workshop that Wyoming Council and Camden Council had with three of the Authority Board Members, Mike Quinn, Jim Winchell and Tracy Torres. Terry Witt also made some comments and Tracy Greenwood (who was not able to attend the workshop) questioned their purchasing policies.

#### PARK/STREET REPORT

- Mr. Witt reported that the street sweeper is in need of a new brush, one of the middle brushes that are more expensive than the gutter brushes. Peach Festival Committee will at least pay for half of it. Ms. Haddick will check on prices.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS

- Peach Festival – Ms. Stokes stated that so far there are 64 vendors that have applied for space at the festival and 9 food people (3 of which are new). We have 12 new crafters so far this year.

- The Noise Ordinance Amendment that was listed on the agenda will be moved to the June Agenda. We are considering putting some times in the ordinance. It is in Barrett's hands and he has not responded back yet.
