

We are in the process of accepting applications for a police officer position. We were awarded the COPS Grant which will cover the 75% of the officer's salary and benefits for 3 years. We are in the process of addressing issues with abandoned/unregistered vehicles on properties in town. If you have any questions pertaining to this matter please feel free to contact us and we will work with you on the matter in order to get it addressed.

Part 1 was about being hit from the rear, part 2 is about being hit from the side. If your vehicle is hit from the side, your airbags will not help you. Your body will be thrown towards the side of the vehicle that was hit. The two items that will help you are your lap and shoulder belts. Also get ready to steer or brake to prevent your vehicle from hitting another vehicle or anything else.
