Dear Camden-Wyoming Sewer & Water Authority Customer,

Recently our maintenance crew has been experiencing a significant increase of unnecessary waste in the sanitary sewer pump station. This can be caused by improper disposal of products that should not be disposed of by flushing.

As a sewer customer you play an important role in keeping the sewer pipeline, on and off your property, blockage free by disposing of the following items in the trash:

Paper towels	Sanitary napkins
Swiffer cloth pads	Baby wipes
Disposable diapers	Cat litter

You can help keep your sewer rates from increasing by following these few simple preventative maintenance tips.

Fats, oil and grease should not be disposed of in the sink. These substances build up on the walls of the sewer pipes and over time will clog the system. Flushing with hot water does not solve the problem. They should be disposed of in the trash can.

Commercial establishments such as restaurants should insure that the grease traps are being used appropriately and that they are being maintained and cleaned on a regular basis.
