Mayor Rife turned the meeting over to Mr. Albert Biddle from Kent County to run the Public Hearing.

Mr. Biddle went through the basics of the Delaware Community Development Block Grant, the amount that will be available for the state and the requirements for applying for the grant. Discussion ensued among Council, the audience and Mr. Biddle. He did his best to answer everyone's questions. Anyone interested in applying and feels that they qualify should contact Town Hall or Mr. Biddle directly to get their name on his list by the end of January. He will apply through Kent County for the grant and will then get everyone to fill out the paperwork to be sure they qualify. The grant is due in by the end of February. He wants at least 5 properties in Wyoming before he will apply as we need 4 qualifying properties to get any funding. Two properties are looking for demolition funds and six others were present hoping to qualify for rehab money.

Ms. Stokes motioned to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Witt seconded the motion. All in favor; none opposed; motion passed.
