We are aware that there were some mistakes. Some bins were delivered where not needed and some residences were missed or not given enough. If you did not receive a bin, please call Town Hall and speak with Pam. If you had bins delivered to you and you should not have received any, please call Town Hall and speak with Pam. Any questions regarding the trash bins at all, please call Pam. Hopefully we can get this all straightened out soon. For those of you who have nice plastic bins that you were using before, you can start using them for yard waste or just as extras in case you have more trash in a week than 1 bin can hold. You can also put excess trash out in bags; just sit them next to your bin on trash day. Thank you for your patience while this project gets completed.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">WYOMING MILL RD.</p> <p>The work on the Wyoming Mill Road Bridge has finally begun. After several false starts due to issues with Norfolk Southern and the work they had to do on the railroad crossing at Camden Wyoming Avenue, the work on the bridge has started. As far as we know their goal is still to have the work completed enough to open up the road before school starts in August; however, sometimes unforeseen issues come up that could prevent that from happening. All detours are clearly marked so if you follow them, you should be OK. Just give yourself some extra time to get where you need to go. Thank you in advance for your patience. We will try to keep you informed of the status on the Wyoming Website (Wyoming.delaware.gov) as the work progresses.</p>	<p>The Wyoming Peach Festival will be held Saturday, August 3rd from 9 am—3 pm. The festival will be kicked off by a parade that will travel west on Camden—Wyoming Avenue beginning at Fifer Middle School. It will end at W. Third Street. Duties would include taking up duct tape, picking up trash, and removing no parking signs.</p> <p>The Peach Festival Committee asks everyone to please leave your pets at home in the coolness of your house rather than bring them to the festival. The asphalt is extremely hot for their tender feet. They don't have shoes to wear as we do. Also, other than the paramedics on bicycles and Lew Denham on a golf cart or tractor, no vehicles of any sort (cars, bikes, skateboards, etc.) will be allowed within the festival area. We also have hired a part time maintenance person to help with all of our summer projects.


