It had to do with moving the utility lines and the high heat we were having at the time. The utilities cannot be moved in high heat. I recently contacted the project manager and was told that they are currently estimating the completion date to be early to mid-September. 		<h2>MOSQUITOS</h2>
	<h2>TREE MAINTAINENCE</h2>	<p>Town Hall has been receiving numerous complaints about how bad insects, mosquitos in particular, have been this year. We have contacted Mosquito Control and they will be spraying during this week in Wyoming. We are being told that it will probably be ground spray (fogging) as opposed to spraying from a plane so expect to see fog trucks going by. Hopefully this will help to cut down the mosquito population at least to some degree.</p>
	<p>During September and October Delmarva Power will be sending tree maintenance crews through town to do routine pruning of trees in the areas of the electric wires. An effective tree maintenance program is critical to Delmarva Power's successful delivery of your electric service. Delmarva Power prunes and removes trees that will grow into or interfere with electric wires and other equipment. There is no charge for these services, and Delmarva Power removes all the debris up to 4 inches in diameter from routine scheduled tree maintenance. If you are aware of any specific problem areas or needs, please contact Town Hall (302-697-2966) so that we can bring it to Delmarva Power's attention.</p>	<h2>DOGS</h2>
		<p>Town Hall has had some complaints from residents finding dog feces in their yards when they do not own a dog. Please be considerate of your neighbors when walking your dogs and carry a bag with you to pick up after them. Also remember it is against Wyoming Ordinance #18-11 "An Ordinance Relating to the Cleaning Up of Animal Waste and Establishing Regulations for the Keeping of Dogs in the Town of Wyoming" not to clean up after your dog. This ordinance also makes it a violation to allow your dog to run at large. You could be fined.</p>
