TRASH, RECYCLING, & YARD WASTE

Town Hall has recently received questions about trash, recycling and yard waste so we want to clear up a few things.

- **Trash** is picked up *every Friday* and they start pick-up VERY early in the morning. We recommend putting your waste bins out Thursday night to be sure they are out in time in the morning. They will not circle back to pick up bins that are put out late. They also will not pick up waste bins that have yard waste in them or recycle bins with trash in them. Be sure to use the proper bin for what you are discarding.
- **Recycling** is picked up *every Tuesday* and must be in the recycle bin you have been provided. Be sure you do not place anything in the recycle bin that is not allowed. There should be a list of what is considered recycling on the top of your bins. If there are items in there that cannot be recycled, the driver may take those items out and leave them in your yard or they may not take any of it. If their truck gets contaminated with items that cannot be recycled, they will have to dump the entire truck in the trash dump and not be allowed in the recycling area. Our driver is very careful not to contaminate her recycling truck. Once again, we recommend that you put your recycle bin out on Monday night so that it will be there no matter how early they begin pick-up.

- **Yard waste** is picked up *every other Tuesday*. The next scheduled yard waste pick-up is Tuesday, September 24th and will continue every other Tuesday after that. If unsure, call the office at 697-2966 or check the calendar on the wyoming.delaware.gov website. Yard waste must be placed in a plastic yard waste bin or any other plastic bin other than your provided waste or recycle bins. You also have the option of purchasing biodegradable bags at a store such as Lowes. You cannot place yard waste in plastic bags. They are not biodegradable. If you have branches to dispose of, they can be cut into 4 foot pieces and tied together in bundles. These can be laid out next to your bin for pick-up rather than placing them in a bin or bag. On a yard waste Tuesday, the recycling is picked up first and the driver comes back later in the day to pick up the yard waste.
- If there is a major holiday during a given week, the pick-up days are pushed forward a day so the recycling and yard waste could be moved to Wednesday and the trash moved to Saturday. We try to place a special notice of this in the monthly newsletter but sometimes it is missed. Hopefully this notice will help to clear up any questions you may have. If you do have other questions, please do not hesitate to contact Town Hall.
