The Wyoming Police Department will have extra officers on duty the night of Halloween, 10/31/13 (Thursday), to ensure the safety and well being of the children that are trick or treating in Wyoming. We will also have extra officers on duty on 10/30/13 (Wednesday), which has always been known as "mischief night".

I would like to announce that the Wyoming Police Department will be teaming up with Camden Police Department in the National Take Back Initiative. This is a program that you can dispose of any unused or any unwanted medications. You can bring the medication to the Camden Police Department on Saturday, October 26th from 10 am to 2 pm or turn the medications over to the Wyoming Police Department to dispose of it. **THIS IS A FREE SERVICE!** If you are unable to bring your unused medications to us then you can call the Wyoming Police Department before 2 pm on Friday, October 25th and we will make arrangements to come and pick them up.

Remember to make sure when you leave your residence that all your windows and doors are locked, along with your vehicles. We are just starting to approach the major holiday season and with this comes an increase in burglaries. If you see any suspicious activity please do not hesitate and call 911 to report it.

Swords, knives, and similar costume accessories should be short, soft, and flexible.



A

Avoid trick-or-treating alone. Walk in groups or with a trusted adult.




F

Fasten reflective tape to costumes and bags to help drivers see you.



E

Examine all treats for choking hazards and tampering before eating them. Limit the amount of treats you eat.



H

Hold a flashlight while trick-or-treating to help you see and others see you. Always WALK and don't run from house to house.



A

Always test make-up in a small area first. Remove it before bedtime to prevent possible skin and eye irritation.



L

Look both ways before crossing the street. Use established crosswalks wherever possible.



L

Lower your risk for serious eye injury by not wearing decorative contact lenses.



O

Only walk on sidewalks whenever possible, or on the far edge of the road facing traffic to stay safe.



W

Wear well-fitting masks, costumes, and shoes to avoid blocked vision, trips, and falls.

E

Eat only factory-wrapped treats. Avoid eating homemade treats made by strangers.



E

Enter homes only if you're with a trusted adult. Only visit well-lit houses. Don't stop at dark houses. Never accept rides from strangers.



N

Never walk near lit candles or luminaries. Be sure to wear flame-resistant costumes
