Punxsutawney Phil and Snow

The good news is that the famous groundhog, Punxsutawney Phil, did not see his shadow on Feb. 2nd which means that Spring is just around the corner. The bad news is that it's only February so there's a good chance we'll be getting more snow.



Please remember that the Town of Wyoming has a snow ordinance whereby each resident is required to shovel snow off their sidewalk and driveway within 48 hours after the snowfall ends. This ordinance was not enforced during our most recent blizzard, Jonas, because of the enormous accumulation of snow and the mess DelDOT made while plowing our streets. Many residents had to shovel several times because after they shoveled, their areas again were covered with snow by the plows. If any additional snow storms come our way, this ordinance will be enforced so plan to have someone available to help you if you are unable to shovel your sidewalk and driveway.

If there are any residents or children of residents who would like to volunteer to shovel snow for any handicapped or elderly residents, please notify Town Hall so we can add your name to our volunteer list. Most people will give a donation to anyone who helps them. Shoveling snow and helping someone who cannot do so is a good way for your teenager to make some extra money. If you are someone who needs assistance with the removal of snow from your sidewalk or driveway, please contact Town Hall so that we can connect you with a volunteer helper.
