In the past, many residents have been extremely helpful in notifying us of a nearby property (often vacant) whose yard is not being cared for or whose grass is not being mowed. We greatly appreciate your letting us know when there is an issue, and we hope you'll continue to do this for us. Please let us know as soon as you are aware that the property is not being cared for—please don't wait until the grass is two feet high! Why? Because we have a procedure in place that requires us to notify the owner by mail and give them several days to take care of the problem themselves. If they don't, the town can take action and mow the property. We have a fee schedule for this type of work so the homeowner will be charged for the work we do. Web Footers Walk


