ORDINANCE #3-11

AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING THE ACCEPTANCE OF STREETS AND RELATED UTILITIES INTO THE TOWN LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WYOMING

WHEREAS, the Town of Wyoming adopted an ordinance regulating the acceptance of streets into the Town of Wyoming in June 2007;

WHEREAS, the ordinance adopted at the time was given an erroneous title;

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires that this ordinance be properly titled;

WHEREAS, the Town Council has repealed the erroneously titled Ordinance #20-07, "An Ordinance Pertaining to the Publishing of Ordinances or Resolutions Relating to the Government of the Town of Wyoming" in anticipation of adoption this ordinance.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Wyoming, a majority thereof concurring in council duly met, that "Ordinance # 3-11, An Ordinance Governing the Acceptance of Streets and Related Utilities into the Town Limits of the Town of Wyoming" be, and hereby is enacted as follows to wit:

AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING THE ACCEPTANCE OF STREETS AND RELATED UTILITIES INTO THE TOWN LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WYOMING

Section 1. The Town of Wyoming shall require prior to any street, road, highway, lane, alley, avenue or other public way being accepted into the town limits, that a closed circuit TV inspection be provided for all storm water and/or sewer system lines to be taken over by the town. The TV inspection shall be accompanied with an audio description of location based on catch basin and/or pipe numbers, which correspond to the numbering system shown on the drawings.

Crossroad culvert pipes, which can be visually inspected, shall be exempt from this requirement. The town shall not accept the storm water and/or sewer system lines, and no bond(s) shall be released, until the Town of Wyoming has approved such TV inspections. Specific requirements are listed below:

- a. The inspections shall be performed by the Camden-Wyoming Sewer & Water Authority.
- b. Forty-eight (48) hours notice shall be given to the Town of Wyoming prior to any inspection so that the Town's inspector may be present.
- c. A type written inspection report documenting the condition of the system shall be submitted with the video and audio tapes.

d. All defects shall be repaired and a subsequent TV inspection shall be performed (following the same guide lines as above).

e. All storm water and/or sewer system lines shall be mandrel tested using a "GO-NO-GO Mandrel". The mandrel tests shall be performed no sooner than 60 days after the installation of the pipe. The Town's inspector shall supervise the inspection.

f. Storm water and/or sewer system lines shall be inspected and eventually accepted by the Town as an inter-connected network, and not on a pipe-by-pipe basis.

g. All filled pipes shall be empty of water prior to TV and mandrel inspections.

h. The Developer/Contractor shall be responsible for all costs which result from the above inspections and necessary repairs.

Synopsis

This Ordinance enacts Ordinance #3-11, An Ordinance Governing the Acceptance of Streets and Related Utilities into the Town Limits of the Town of Wyoming. There are no substantive changes between the text of this ordinance and the erroneously titled ordinance it replaces. The purpose of this ordinance is to correct the title of the previous ordinance that was originally given an incorrect title.
