Town Elections

With elections taking place on February 25th, we need three volunteers to work the polls and three volunteers to be on the Election Board. The poll workers need to be at Town Hall by Noon as the polls open at 1 p.m. and close at 8 p.m. The Board of Election members need to meet at Town Hall at 10 a.m. to open and tally the absentee votes. Then they need to be available by phone for the rest of the day in case there are any issues at the polls. They will then meet at the polls at 8 p.m. to announce the results of the election. If you're interested in either of these positions, please contact Town Hall and send a letter of interest to Wyoming Town Hall, 1 N. Railroad Avenue, Wyoming, DE 19934 as soon as possible as these people need to be appointed at the December 5th Council Meeting. This is a great way to support your town without having to put out a lot of time. Thank you in advance to all volunteers.

Reminder to anyone interested in running for Mayor or one of the two available council seats: you must pick up your election packet from Town Hall and submit all of your paperwork, INCLUDING the RESULTS of your criminal background check, to Town Hall no later than 4:30 p.m. on Friday, January 27, 2017.

Reminder for Residents

Anyone doing major repairs, replacements or additions to their homes or properties must apply for a building permit before beginning the work. Building permits take approximately 48-72 hours. If you're uncertain if you need a permit, please call and ask. Please do not apply for a permit the day the work is to begin. Also, any contractor you hire to do your work must have a Town of Wyoming Contractor's License. To apply for a license, they must supply us with a completed application
