Election Reminder

Interested in running for a seat on our Town Council? Two seats are open and both are for two year terms. If you're interested, you must have your letter of intent and the results of your criminal background check from the State Bureau of Investigation (SBI) to Town Hall no later than Friday, January 29th at 4:30 p.m. If you need to contact the SBI regarding available times and the location of where to have your fingerprints checked, contact them at 302-739-2528.

To be eligible to run for Town Council, you must be at least 21 years of age by the date of the election, a citizen of the State of Delaware, a qualified elector, and a bona fide domiciliary in the Town of Wyoming for at least one year prior to the date of the election.
