ORDINANCE # P3-07

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PLAYING OF CERTAIN GAMES UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE TOWN OF WYOMING AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFORE

Whereas the Wyoming Town Council finds that they playing of games upon the public streets or highways of the Town is a source of annoyance to motorists attempting to pass through the area and poses a danger of physical injury to the participants therein be it ordained that the Town of Wyoming in Council met:

Section -1- No person or persons shall engage in the playing of any game upon any public street's or highway's within the Town of Wyoming. Games for the purpose of this section shall include but not be limited to, basketball, football, soccer, handball, stickball, baseball or any other game which by it very nature would tend to annoy motorists, and or interfere with or impede vehicular traffic and or impose a danger to the participants.

Section -2- The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to public events sanctioned by the Wyoming Town Council

Section -3- Penalties- Violations of this ordinance shall be a Misdemeanor. Persons convicted thereof shall be fined no less than \$50.00 and no more than \$100.00 for the second or subsequent offense. The Justice of the Peace Court shall have jurisdiction over violations of this ordinance.
