Winter is still here!

Although our weather can't seem to make up its mind if it's Winter or Spring, there's still plenty of time to have some of that wintery white snow. Please keep the following in mind the next time it snows:

- Parking on the Streets during Snowfall:
 - All vehicles must be removed from the streets that are marked for no parking after one hour of snowfall. The Police Department can tow any vehicles left in the streets at the owner's expense. Streets must remain free of vehicles until after the snow has been cleared.
- Removing Snow from Sidewalks:

Sidewalks in front of your house and leading to your mailbox must be cleared within 48 hours after the snowfall has stopped. This is a safety factor for you, any residents walking on the sidewalk, and your mail delivery person. If the sidewalks are not cleared, the mail may not be delivered.

If anyone is willing to help a disabled or senior citizen shovel their sidewalks, please call Town Hall and we will put your name on a calling list. If you need help, call Town Hall (302-697-2966) and we'll try to find someone to help you.



Property Tax Discounts

Property Tax time is right around the corner. The Town of Wyoming downloads all of its tax information from Kent County. If you think you might qualify for a senior citizen low income discount or a handicapped discount, you must go to the Kent County Tax Office at 555 Bay Road in Dover to apply. If you qualify with Kent County, the information will automatically download to us, and we will give you the discount also. Don't wait until the last minute. Kent County's information will be downloaded to us around the middle of May.
