The following resident has filed for the Mayor's seat: Steve Bilbrough. As there are no other candidates for the Mayor's seat, Mr. Bilbrough will be sworn into office in May. Congratulations Mr. Bilbrough!

Fire Hydrants

Fire Hydrants play a key role in firefighting. Having an obstacle, such as a parked car, in front of a hydrant can cause delays for our fire department personnel. Damage to your car may occur if a fire emergency occurs while you are parked in front of a fire hydrant.

Title 21 Chapter 41 of the Delaware code states: "No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic-control device, including all state-owned and/or state leased property; in any of the following places.....within 15 feet of a fire hydrant." Please be mindful where you are parking & keep the fire hydrants clear for emergency personnel.
