### Back to School

Now that our children are back to school, it's important for drivers to remember to follow the law regarding stopping for school buses.

In Delaware, it's illegal to overtake or pass a stopped school bus. Flashing yellow lights on a school bus indicate it's preparing to stop to load or unload children—and motorists should slow down and prepare to stop. Red flashing lights and an extended stop arm indicate that the bus has stopped and children are getting on and off. Motorists are required to stop their vehicles and wait until the red lights stop flashing, the extended stop sign is withdrawn, and the bus begins moving before they can start driving again.

If a school bus is stopped and letting children on or off, these traffic laws must be obeyed. To avoid getting charged with a traffic violation/hefty fine, you must adhere to these traffic laws. Passing a stopped school bus in Delaware is illegal because you could hit, injure, or kill a child getting on or off the school bus. Please protect our children and drive safely.


