Trash/Recycling/Yard Waste Bins

Please do not place any trash, recycling or yard waste bins in the roadway. The best placement is at the end of your driveway or edge of your property. Placing bins in the roadway can cause problems with the flow of traffic and prevent the street sweeper from cleaning that area of the street.

Bulk, recycling or trash should be put out the evening before pick-up. Your schedule is as follows: Tuesday- Recycling/ yard waste (every other week), Wednesday -
