Word from Wyoming

Wanted: Candidates for 2023 Election!

Elections for Wyoming Town Council will be held in February. Council will have openings for two council seats and one Mayor seat. Council seats terms are for two years. Mayor seat term is for 3 years. If you are interested, please stop into Town Hall on or after November 30th to pick up an election packet. To be put on the ballot, candidates must file their papers and a copy of the background check with the Town of Wyoming no later than 4:30 p.m. on Friday January 27, 2023.

Qualifications for mayor and council members are as follows:

- ♦ must be 21 years of age by the date of the election,
- ♦ must be a citizen of the State of Delaware,
- ♦ must be a qualified elector,
- ♦ and must be a bona fide domiciliary of the Town for at least one year prior to the date of the election.

Candidates must supply the Town with the results of a criminal background check at the time they file to run. These checks must be done at the State Bureau of Investigation which is located on S. Bay Road in Dover. Call 739-5871 to check on times and to make an appointment.



*****To vote in Town of Wyoming elections, you must be registered with the Kent County Department of Elections and be at least 18 years of age with photo ID.

Q: Why do I need a permit?

A building permit allows you to legally begin construction on your home project. Having a permit proves that your project drawings have been cleared and met all necessary specifications. It also gives you satisfaction that your project is safe and compliant.

Q: What projects require a permit?

New Construction, additions, garages, pole buildings, sheds, gazebos, porches, pergolas, patio, pool, fences, sidewalks, driveways, solar panels, roof, siding, windows, demolition and remodeling.
