## Assessments & Tax Bills

Wyoming tax bills are determined by Kent County's property assessment. In the beginning of May, Kent County will send Wyoming the assessment list which will be posted for your review. The list will be posted the beginning of June on the website (<https://wyoming.delaware.gov/>), inside Town Hall, the Post Office, and at Mike and Mel's. We ask that you review your assessed value for correctness. If you see a discrepancy in your assessment, please call the Kent County Assessment Office **(302) 744-2386**.

The actual tax bills from Wyoming will be mailed out around July 1. They will be due no later than September 30<sup>th</sup> 2023. However, if paid in full by July 31<sup>st</sup> 2023, you will earn an early payment discount. If you do not feel you can pay your tax in full by September 30<sup>th</sup>, please call Town Hall to set up a payment plan which can be weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly.
