Multipurpose Court and Playground

The Town of Wyoming worked hard to find funding to install a multipurpose court and improve the playground at Wyoming Park for all to enjoy. Staff have noticed these facilities are not being respected and equipment is being abused in some cases. Trash is being found inside the fenced playground area and the court. Trash cans are provided, please use the cans for your trash and take your personal belongings when you leave. The equipment on the multipurpose court such as the rims are being hung on and the fence is being climbed on. Climbing/jumping the fence around the playground and multipurpose court is prohibited. We ask that you close the gate at the playground as it is for the safety of all children.

If these activities are observed, you will be asked to leave. If you are caught causing damage, you will be charged and liable for the cost of repairs.

If the disrespect and abuse of facilities continue, hours may be modified and/or closure of court.

Yard Waste

Yard waste is grass, grass clippings, bushes, shrubs, and clippings from bushes and shrubs. Place extra leaves and yard clippings in cardboard boxes, paper bags or special yard waste containers that are 50lbs or less. Limbs must be less than 3 inches in diameter. You will need to bundle and tie in bundles no longer than 4 feet long.

You can purchase a 95 gallon yard waste container from Wyoming Town Hall. It is a one-time purchase and the container is yours to keep.



Back to School

Business and Landlord Licenses

Most Business and Landlord licenses expire on September 30, 2023. Letters and renewal applications are being mailed to current business owners and landlords. If you do not receive one by mid-September or your address has changed, please contact Town Hall. You can also print the forms needed from the Town's website @ https://wyoming.delaware.gov/forms/.

Taxes

Property taxes are due by September 30th. If you are unable to pay your taxes in full, please contact the staff at Town Hall to make payment arrangements.

Bulk Waste

Bulk waste includes items that are typically too large to be disposed of in your regular curbside trash container. To help you get rid of these large items, your trash provider will pick up these items every Wednesday in the Town of Wyoming. You will want to put your items out to the curb no later than Tuesday evening to ensure pick up.

Bulk items typically include:

Couches- When you're getting rid of old items like sofas and chairs, simply leave it assembled.

Lamps- Remove light bulbs.

Rugs - please roll up as it is easier for disposal.

Mattresses- When disposing of old mattresses, it's helpful to wrap the mattress in plastic for safe and efficient disposal.

Large Appliances without Freon- must have a tag certifying that Freon has been removed or item will be left behind. Remove doors from appliances like refrigerators and washing machines.
