

# <u>Wanted:</u> Candidates for 2024 Election!

Elections will be coming up in February. Council will have the following seats to be filled:

- Two (2) Council seats with a term of office of two (2) years (March 2024 to March 2026)
- Mayor Seat (1) with a term of the remaining time (2) years of three (3) years (March 2024 to March 2026)
- One (1) Council seat with a term of the remaining time (1) year of two (2) years (March 2024 to March 2025)

If you are interested, please stop into Town Hall to pick up an election packet. To be put on the ballot, candidates must file their papers and a copy of the background check with the Town of Wyoming no later than 4:30 p.m. on Friday January 26, 2024.

Qualifications for mayor and council members are as follows:

- ⇒ must be 21 years of age by the date of the election,
- ⇒ must be a citizen of the State of Delaware,
- ⇒ must be a qualified elector,
- ⇒ and must be a bona fide domiciliary of the Town for at least one year prior to the date of the election.

Candidates must supply the Town with the results of a criminal background check at the time they file to run. These checks must be done at the State Bureau of Investigation which is located on S. Bay Road in Dover. Call 739-5871 to check on times and to make an appointment.



\*\*\*\*\*To vote in Town of Wyoming elections, you must be registered with the Kent County Department of Elections and be at least 18 years of age with photo ID.
