The Town of Wyoming will NOT be having a council election on February 24, 2024.

### **Council Positions:**

- Mayor Seat (1) with a term of the remaining time (2) years of three (3) years (March 2024 to March 2026)
- Only one (1) candidate filed for this position-filling the open seat:
  - Doug Denison
- Two (2) Council seats with a term of office of two (2) years (March 2024 to March 2026)
- One (1) Council seat with a term of the remaining time (1) year of two (2) years (March 2024 to March 2025)
- Only three (3) candidates filed for these positions filling the open seats:
  - Tracy Johovic
  - Kyle Dixon
  - Cathy George

The incumbents will be sworn into their respective positions at the March 4, 2024 Council Meeting.
