At the May 6th council meeting, Council reviewed estimates from several waste management companies. Council voted to remain with Republic Services for the town's trash, recycling, bulk and yard waste needs.



Yard Waste containers will now be included in our contract. Every resident will receive a yard waste receptacle. Receptacles are expected to be delivered around the end of June and beginning of July.

Starting July 1st, bulk will no longer be picked up weekly. Bulk waste will be picked up the last Friday of the month.
