



Yard Waste Debris

On Monday October 7, 2024, Wyoming Town Council amended the Grass ordinance to prohibit yard waste such as leaves and grass to be disposed of in a public right-of-way.

"Section 5. Disposal of yard waste in the public right-ofway. It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit, place, discard, dispose, drop, or in any other manner scatter any yard waste in or upon the public right-of-way. Anything herein to the contrary notwithstanding, nothing in this section shall be construed as prohibiting the temporary scattering of yard waste on the public right-of-way where the same occurs incidental to and during mowing, raking, or clipping operations, but the same shall thereafter be removed and corrected immediately at the conclusion of such operations. "

Land Use and Development Code Amendment

Town Council and Planning and Zoning have worked closely to add an amendment in the Land Use and Development Code (LUDC) regarding Marijuana-based businesses in Wyoming. On Monday October 7th, Council adopted Ordinance #73-24 which amends the LUDC.

"This ordinance amends the Land Use and Development Code of the Town of Wyoming to permit marijuana establishments in the C and I-1 zoning districts only, subject to conditional use approval. This ordinance also states that no conditional use permits for a Marijuana Cultivation Facility, Marijuana Product Manufacturing Facility, Marijuana Testing Facility, or Marijuana Retail Store will be accepted until after April 1, 2027. "
