With warmer weather and longer days coming, it's time most start cleaning up their yards. Every resident should have a yard waste container. If you do not please contact Town Hall at 302-697-2966.

Here is a reminder of what can go in your can: grass, leaves and branches. Dirt is not yard waste but part of your yard.

Branches (no longer than 4ft) should be bundled and tied together. Piles should be no higher than 4ft tall.


Attached to this newsletter is the Wyoming Grass Ordinance. Please note that you are subject to fines if you dispose of your yard waste in a public right of way (road).



Wrecked, Dismantled, Inoperable or Unregistered Vehicles In Wyoming

In the town of Wyoming, Ordinance #8-11 states— "No person shall park, store, leave or abandon or permit the parking, storing, leaving or abandonment of, any wrecked, dismantled, or inoperable vehicle, or any unregistered vehicle, of any kind, whether attended or not, upon any public or private property within the Town for a period of time in excess of 72 hours for public property and 15 days for private property."

Violations of this Ordinance can result in fines and/or the towing of the vehicle in violation.



2025-2026 Town Budget
