## Election

The Town of Wyoming will NOT be having a council election on February 28, 2026.

Council Positions:

- Mayor Seat (1) with a term of three (3) years (March 2026 to March 2029)
- Only one (1) candidate filed for this position- filling the open seat:
  - Doug Denison
- Two (2) Council seats with a term of office of two (2) years (March 2026 to March 2028)
- Only three (3) candidates filed for these positions - filling the open seats:
  - Tracy Johovic
  - Kyle Dixon

The incumbents will be sworn into their respective positions at the March 2, 2026 Council Meeting.

## Council Vacancy

Interested in being involved in your local government? Wyoming town council has a vacancy to fill due to a resignation.

Candidate would finish the last year of the current term and participate in the next election in 2027 to remain on council.
