Tax Discounts

Persons 65 years of age or older by May 31st and/or persons totally (100%) disabled, and able to document their total disability, may qualify to receive a reduction in the amount of their taxable assessment which would reduce or eliminate their property tax liability. Contact the Assessment office at 302-744-2401 for further questions. Deadline is April 30, 2026.



Grass in Wyoming

It's that time of the year again! Warm weather and grass. Important things to remember regarding the town's grass ordinance.

- Keep grass **under 8 inches**
- Remove weeds from **hard surfaces** (sidewalks, walkways, etc)
- Keep yard **clear of debris**
- **Do not leave clippings in the street**

Otherwise, the town can:

- Issue a warning
- Fine you

Or mow/clean it themselves and bill you .

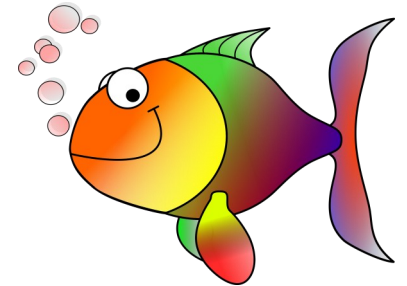


ANNUAL FISHING DERBY

Carted Yard Waste Program Guidelines

All yard waste, such as grass clippings, leaves, tree branches, twigs, brush, shrubs, bushes and weeds, must be placed UNBAGGED into the new Republic Services yard waste carts.

- **Do NOT bag yard waste** – Bags of yard waste will NOT be collected. Bags cannot be mulched.
- **All yard waste must be placed inside a cart.**
- **Do NOT overfill cart** – Lid should be closed. Overfilled carts cannot be collected.
- **Tree branches** – Tree branches must be 3 inches in diameter or smaller, must be cut to a length of 4 feet or less, and must be tied securely into bundles. Tree branches sticking out of a cart CANNOT be collected, as they are a safety hazard.
- **Restricted items** – Restricted items CANNOT be collected. These include mulch, dirt, pavers, railroad ties, fencing, concrete and rocks.
