CALL TO ORDER –Mayor Denison called the meeting to order at 6:30p.m.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Ms. Johovic moved with a second from Mrs. Wooleyhand to adopt the agenda with a correction to date- changing Monday to Tuesday. Mayor Denison, Vice-Mayor Johovic, Mr. Dixon and Mrs. Wooleyhand, Aye. None Opposed. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

- Mr. Musselman stated he does not agree with the street marking that is taking place on E. Broad and N. Railroad Ave. Feels that the street should not be marked for a once-a-year event. Mr. Musselman stated that he would mark around his house before event but doesn't want it to look disorderly the rest of the year.

TREASURERS REPORT

- Mr. Dixon advised reports were in packets for review.
- Mr. Dixon stated that council would need to schedule the upcoming budget meetings. A proposed date of 6/8 or 6/9 for initial meeting. 6/22-6/24 for final meeting.

POLICE REPORT

- Mayor Denison presented April's police report to the council. There were 13 traffic tickets, 20 special duty tickets, 136 town ordinance tickets, 40 warnings, 6 criminal arrests, 1 local fugitive, 0 accidents, and 156 total complaints handled by the WPD.
- Speed trailer was set up on Camden Wyoming Ave. It showed a total of 144,292 cars traveling during time period. 1454 vehicles over excessive speed.

PARK/STREET

- Maintenance workers have been working on painting curbs within the Greens of Wyoming.
- Street Sweeping has started and being done on a weekly basis.

- DR Horton extension
 - Mayor Denison explained that DR Horton is asking for an extension as they are awaiting final approval to record plot plan. Town code states development must start within 1 year after recording the plan. Therefore a 6-month extension is needed.
 - Council approved the 6-month extension.
- Vacant Council Seat
 - Mayor Denison stated that 3 letters of interest were received.
 - Mayor Denison asked council for nominations.
 - Mr. Dixon nominated Josette Threatts. He states she is a long-time resident, worked alongside Mrs. Threatts in leadership opportunities. Mrs. Threatts is retired from education and has a vested interest in the town.

Mr. Dixon moved with a second from Ms. Johovic to accept nomination of Josette Threatts for the vacant council seat. Mayor Denison, Vice-Mayor Johovic, Mr. Dixon and Mrs. Wooleyhand, Aye. None Opposed. Motion carried.
