Proper Cart Placement Is the Key to Automated Service



- Have the cart at the curb by 6 a.m. on your collection day.
- Place the cart at least 5 feet from any object – like a car, tree, pole, fire hydrant, mailbox, electrical box, or cable box – so the automated arm can reach your cart.
- Please maintain this same distance of 5 feet between recycling and waste carts.
- Don't lean anything against the cart.
- Don't place your cart under a tree.
- Carts should be placed within two feet from the curb or edge of the street.
- Place the cart with the arrows on the lid pointing toward the street and the handle toward your house.
- Remember to close the lid of the cart.
- Please don't allow children to play in or around the carts. Our trucks use mechanical arms to pick up the recycling and waste carts.

Grass Clippings

Please Keep Our Streets & Rights-of-Way Clear!

It is **unlawful** to deposit, place, discard, dispose of, drop, or otherwise scatter **yard waste** in or upon any public right-of-way.

This includes grass clippings, leaves, branches, and other yard debris.

Temporary scattering of yard waste that occurs **incidentally during mowing, raking, or clipping** is permitted. However, **all yard waste must be removed immediately when the work is completed.**

PLEASE DO NOT BLOW OR LEAVE GRASS CLIPPINGS AND YARD WASTE IN THE STREET.

Violators are subject to fines.

TOWN ORDINANCE SECTION 8: ANIMAL WASTE

It is unlawful to allow your dog to defecate on public or private property owned by others. You must immediately remove and properly dispose of your dog's waste.

PENALTIES:

1ST OFFENSE
\$50⁰⁰

2ND OFFENSE
\$100⁰⁰

3RD & SUBSEQUENT
OFFENSES
\$300⁰⁰

EXCEPTIONS: This ordinance does not apply to guide dogs assisting a blind person or dogs assisting other physically challenged individuals.
